

Impact of Supreme Court Ruling on Sales Tax Rules

The impact of the June 21, 2018 U.S. Supreme Court ruling in *South Dakota v. Wayfair* will be felt by nearly every retailer and consumer. Removing the limitation means that nearly all catalog, online, and remote sales will have sales taxes collected by the retailer to be remitted to the proper jurisdictions, at least in states that impose a sales tax. For consumers, this means that the taxes will be the same on purchases made in brick-and-mortar stores and those made online. For retailers, the impact is much larger.
